## Motocross Races 1:00PM EST Sat.

This will be our second year of having the organized motocross races. Last year was great, but this time we are going to kick it up a couple of notches. The top 3 winners in each class will receive a trophy. We have 6 classes we will be running this year. They are listed to the right. Each class will run 2 motos, 3 laps in the first moto with the number of laps in the 2nd one TBD. Please have at least a 2 digit number on your trike in two places to help ease scoring. If you are interested in competing in the MX race(s) please stop by the pavilion for signup and more information on classes and number plates.

### MX CLASSES

- 2 Stroke Open
- 4 Stroke Open
- Mid-size Suspended
- Semi-Suspended
- Unsuspended
- Mini Quads

The 2 stroke open class will be for any 2 stroke machine that wants to run. The 4 stroke open class is the same except for 4 strokes. Mid size suspended is 250cc and under 4 strokes. Semi suspended is no rear suspension (mono shock) but telescopic front forks. Unsuspended is no mono shock, no telescopic front forks. Mini Quads is small quads under 125cc both 2 and 4 stroke.

What started off as just an attempt to get everyone together for a picture at Trikefest 02 has turned into a yearly ritual. The group picture is a rare opportunity to have so many three-wheelers and their riders together in place that welcomes them.
